# **Public Forum**

CP advises that Peter Bellfield is unlikely to attend due to ill health, and good wishes are sent to him by all present.

CP addresses the meeting regarding her election to office, the conservative majority and the fact that one-third of the DC Councillors are new.

CP reviewed environmental issues and polies, and in particular issues regarding Brown Bin collections, and a potential charge for collections based on costs in separating food and other recyclable waste. While the DC could afford to fund this, there was ongoing need to secure savings, and there are plans for the unit at Parham to be transferred to Felixstowe, with some consideration also given to cheap domestic anaerobic digesters as a solution to food waste. Solutions found by other councils and areas, including separate small brown bins for food waste were raised.

TC raised the issue of £1,200 provided by Bob Snell previously for Vehicle Activated Signs (VAS) on the B1078, and reviewed the issues in dealing with the County Council and their studies based on misleading and irrelevant criteria. CP confirmed that road safety on rural roads was a major issue and that she anticipated funding issues arising, but this was really a matter for PB and the new Portfolio Holder at the County Council, but agreed to raise the issue with the CC Leader as this was an important issue in many villages in the area. There was general concern that this issue was not being taken seriously despite the fatal accident on the B1078 involving Dominic Davis last August, and TC agreed to forward relevant material to CP, who also recommended that TC sent the Portfolio Holder a letter and involve the local Member of Parliament.

ML raised a planning / environment issue regarding noise from dogs kennelled at Seven Spar Farm, adjacent to his farm in South Letheringham. Despite conditions being imposed and not adhered to, there was no real enforcement or proper ongoing assessment and the noise pollution continued on a daily basis. ML commented favourably on the intervention of the new Officer, Louise Burns, but CP conceded

that there was an issue regarding enforcement by rural councils generally and asked ML to email her requesting that she address this matter on his behalf, and that in response she would speak to the Environmental health Officer and do what she could to assist in resolving this issue, which has been going on for 6 years.

The public forum closed at 8.40 pm and the Parish Council Meeting began.

### 2015.38 Apologies

TC reported that 4 pence interest had been earned on the deposit account, and that the £1,750 received from Adnam's would be paid into the Community Account and would be spent this year, and these factors raised the balance in the Community and Business accounts from £3,055.54 to £4,805.58.

# 2015.44 Phone Box

As stated above, a cheque had been received from The Adnam's Charity for £1,750 in respect of the costs of installing a defibrillator in the Phone Box.

Paula was unable to attend the meeting, which was unfortunate as this funding arose from her idea, input and efforts, and the meeting congratulated and thanked her for this.

There remained an issue regarding ongoing funding to maintain this once installed, as well as regarding the painting of the Phone Box with the correct colour and to ensure that there is an appropriate electrical supply, and funding 7 agreement for this.

DA to liaise with Paula regarding these issues and next steps, including what LPC and other parties need to do, and what can be



achieved through discussions with BT regarding maintenance and electrical supply etc.

# 2015.45 B1078

TC reported that the Coroners Inquest relating to the fatal accident involving Dominic Davis in August 2014 was to be held in Lowestoft on the 25<sup>th</sup> August 2015. TC had been called to attend to give evidence, and had met with Dominic's mother last week.

TC had read and considered the Police Report regarding this incident, which had not come to any firm conclusion regarding the cause of the accident.

It was agreed that any further response would await the view of the Coroner, Mr. Peter Dean, and his recommendations to the County Council, if any, regarding issues arising generally, and in relation to traffic control measures in the relevant location in particular.

# 2015.46 Maverick festival

The meeting considered the impact of this on residents, which was minimal and within generally accepted levels, albeit that it was noted that the noise appeared to be louder on the Friday evening than at other times.

On balance, it was agreed that there were no issues and concerns that required attention, and a note to this effect should be sent to those responsible.
